Leslie E. loves spending time with her family for Christmas. She stays home and has her family come to her. They enjoy their Christmas meal which includes chicken and rice.

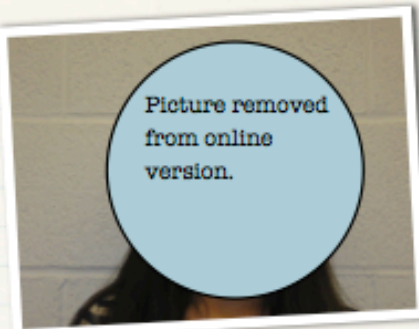
